

# Peterhead 2001 Street Furniture

(For Derek Lovejoy Scotland)

The brief was to design street furniture which was site specific to Peterhead and constructed using Peterhead pink granite. The street furniture was also required to be designed to closely integrate with the design for the streetscape improvements, which were at the time being carried out by Aberdeen City Council (also designed and implemented by DLP Edinburgh).

Designed to integrate as part of a Town Centre Streetscape Refurbishment Project, the Peterhead litter bins, benches and lit bollards were designed and constructed, where possible, from Peterhead granite. The timber for the benches was both locally sourced and milled Oak. The litter bins, benches and bollards were all fabricated locally demonstrating Aberdeenshire Council's commitment to support local employment while also enabling them to enhance the local environment, and demonstrating their consideration for wider environmental issues.
