Entrance Enhancements 2001.

The prestigious headquarters for financial asset management company AEGON UK Plc. is sited in the award winning Edinburgh Park.

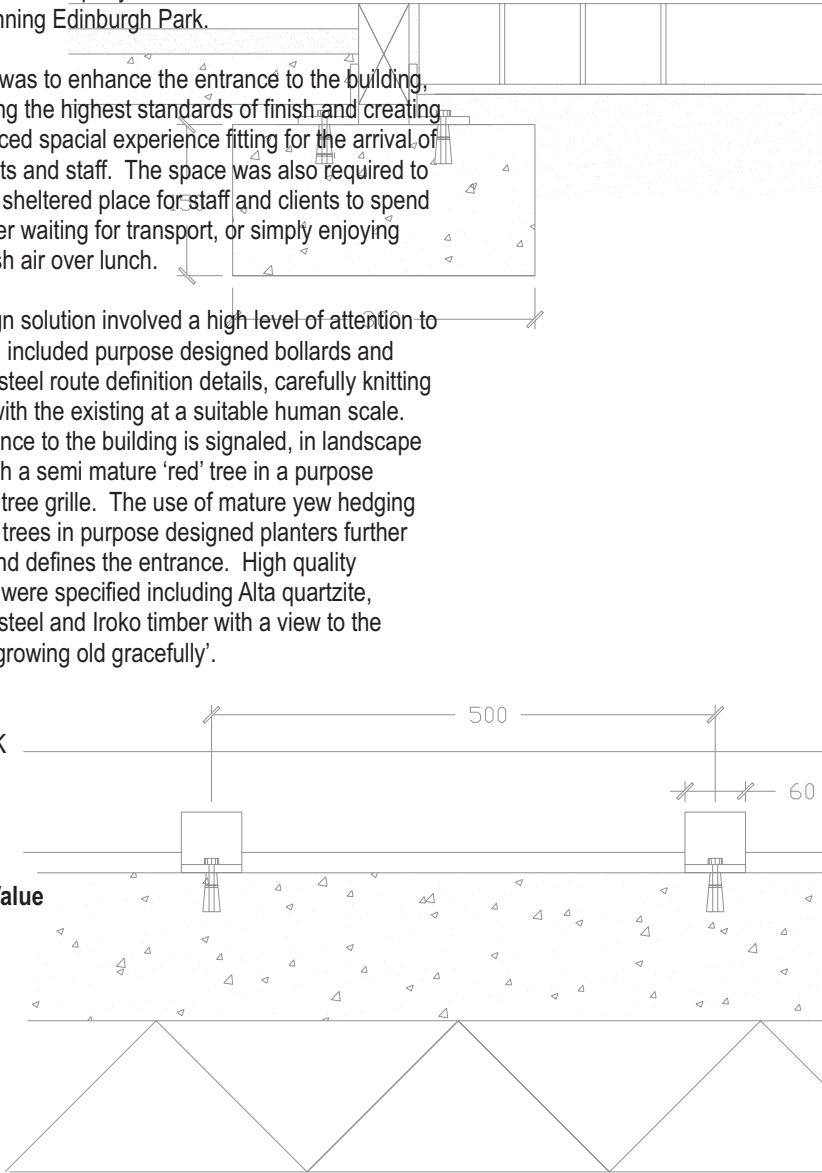
The brief was to enhance the entrance to the building, maintaining the highest standards of finish and creating an enhanced spacial experience fitting for the arrival of both clients and staff. The space was also required to provide a sheltered place for staff and clients to spend time, either waiting for transport, or simply enjoying some fresh air over lunch.

The design solution involved a high level of attention to detail and included purpose designed bollards and stainless steel route definition details, carefully knitting the new with the existing at a suitable human scale. The entrance to the building is signaled, in landscape terms, with a semi mature 'red' tree in a purpose designed tree grille. The use of mature yew hedging and birch trees in purpose designed planters further softens and defines the entrance. High quality materials were specified including Alta quartzite, stainless steel and Iroko timber with a view to the scheme 'growing old gracefully'.

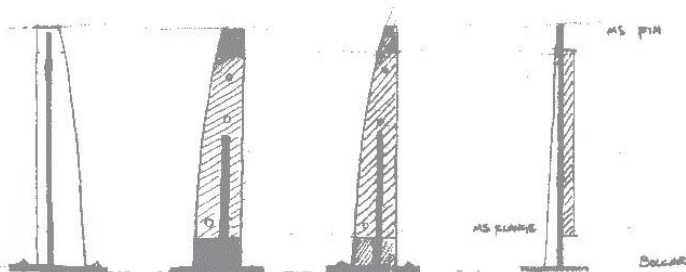
